



## Patient Belongings List

Items to be brought by the patient for admission, or that can be brought after admission takes place by a family member or friend. We want your stay to be as comfortable as possible, however for your safety and the safety of other patients, items not permitted on the unit will be sent home or locked in the patient storage area until discharge. All items are inventoried and the disposition on the Patient Inventory sheet within the chart.

\*Please bring current medications list you are taking with you for verification, including inhalers and OTC medications. (Please do not bring the medication).

\*3-4 sets of clothing/underwear, socks and pj's (no strings, ties, or hosiery.) A washer and dryer are available on the

\*Personal care items, combs, brushes, oral care products, contact lens supplies will be provided for you. You are not permitted to bring your own personal care items.

\*All personal care products will be stored and given out during designated hours. All products must be turned back in after use for storage for safety reasons. No supplies may be stored in your room.

\*All clothing must be of appropriate dress, no tube tops, and fishnet type material are to be worn as well as extremely tight fitting/revealing blouses, shirts or shorts. Clothing must not have any gang/drug/sexual or racial related messages or prints. Items with strings (i.e. hoodies, sweatpants etc) are not permitted unless the strings are removed.

Underwire bras are not permitted. Sport bras are recommended.

### Items that will be sent home or stored

\*No outside food, candy or drinks

\*Cell phones, Ipods, Notebooks

\*Glass, metal, hard plastic objects,

\*Spiral/wire binder notebooks

\*Matches, lighters, aerosol sprays, any flammable liquid

\*Guns, knives, scissors, any type of a weapon,

\* Drug paraphernalia

\*Pornographic materials

\*Nail polish, files or polish remover

Cash, bank cards, wallets, purses will be stored in the nursing station under lock and key. You may keep limited amounts of jewelry, wedding bands, ect, however, some jewelry may need to be removed for safety reasons
